Suspension of Minor Illness Program (MIP) Privileges

In order to prepare for the upcoming Presidential Inauguration event, the Department will suspend the **Minor Illness Program (MIP)** privileges from January 15, 2013 at 0001hrs until January 26, 2013 at 0001hrs. Any member going off sick shall report to the Police & Fire Clinic during sick call. The PFC will be opened for extended hours—from 0700 hours to 2300 hours—during this time period. Members that report sick after 2300 hours shall report to the PFC the next sick call at 0700 hours.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 5-405(h), the Budget Support Act restrictions on overtime compensation “shall not apply during pay periods 1 and 2 of calendar year 2013.” Accordingly, during this period of suspended MIP privileges, all uniformed and civilian members of the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department are exempt from the overtime compensation limitations set forth in D.C. Official Code §§ 5-405(f) and (g).
